Instructions for completing this form:

- *Sponsor*- Enter your club or organization name.
- *Classroom Dates**- If applicable: Enter date(s) of proposed class. Allow *at least 3* weeks lead time.
- *Classroom Location**- If applicable: Enter the name of the building or facility, the room name or number (if applicable) and the street address, including zip code.
- *Classroom Times**- If applicable: Enter the times the class will be held. If there will be different times on different dates, enter that information clearly.
- *Field Training Dates*- Enter the date or dates the field training will be offered.
- *Field Training Location*- Enter the name of the facility, the field name or number (if applicable) and the street address, including zip code.
- *Field Training Times*- Enter the times the field training will be held. If there will be different times on different dates, enter that information clearly.
- *Class Size*- Enter the maximum class size possible given classroom space limitations. Note: ORC approval is required if you wish to serve more than 25 students in a course.
- *Contact*- Enter the name of the primary contact for this class, and a telephone number and/or e-mail address for this individual. Please also note whether ORC may release this information to prospective students.
